SCHOMBERG- ONTARIO

UPDATE:

Ministry of the Environment, Conservation and Parks personnel are on site and monitoring the situation for any potential impacts to water and/or air quality. At present there has been no advisement of any risk. The Township is working closely with ministry staff and will provide updates as they become available.

The Trisan Centre has been closed and will remain out of operation for the remainder of the day. Any rentals, classes or programs are cancelled.

PREVIOUS INFORMATION:

Fire personnel responded to a structure fire at 71 Proctor Road this morning at 5:20am. The site houses hazardous materials.

Crews are onsite dealing with the situation. There are no current concerns for the residents or businesses in the area. Out of precaution several adjacent business areas have been evacuated.

There are several road closures currently in effect as follows:

- Highway 27 from Lloydtown-Aurora Road to Leonard
- Proctor Road
- Dillane Drive
- Highway 9 – Main Street to Leonard

Police are urging drivers to avoid the area.

The Township will continue to monitor the situation and provide further updates as they become available.
