

**THE CORPORATION OF THE TOWNSHIP OF KING**

**BY-LAW NUMBER 2002-58**

**A BY-LAW TO AMEND BY-LAW NUMBER 97-84, as amended, BEING A BY-LAW TO CONTROL THE DUMPING OF FILL AND ALTERATION OF GRADES**

**WHEREAS** By-law Number 97-84, as amended, provides for regulating the dumping of fill and alteration of grades in the Township of King;

**AND WHEREAS** Council has deemed that By-law Number 97-84, as amended, shall be further amended;

**NOW THEREFORE** the Council of the Corporation of the Township of King **HEREBY ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:**

**1. DEFINITIONS**


In this By-law:


- (a) "CLERK" means the Clerk of the Corporation of the Township of King.
  - (b) "OAK RIDGES MORaine CONSERVATION ACT, 2001" means the Oak Ridges Moraine Conservation Act, S.O. 2001, c.31 enacted by the Province of Ontario, December 14, 2001, and any amendments thereto.
  - (c) "OAK RIDGES MORaine CONSERVATION PLAN" means the Oak Ridges Moraine Conservation Plan established by regulation by the Minister of Municipal Affairs for all or part of the Oak Ridges Moraine Area, and any amendments thereto.
2. The issuance of any and all Fill Permits for lands within the Oak Ridges Moraine shall be in strict compliance with and no Fill Permit shall issue which contravenes, the *Oak Ridges Moraine Conservation Act, 2001* and the Oak Ridges Moraine Conservation Plan.
  3. No person may place or dump fill or cause fill to be placed or dumped and no person may alter the grade of any land or cause the grade of any land to be altered except in strict compliance with the Oak Ridges Moraine Conservation Plan. A Fill Permit may include conditions to address the requirements of the Oak Ridges Moraine Conservation Plan.
  4. A Fill Permit will only be issued if, in addition to compliance with all other requirements, the intended use for the filled area is a permitted use under the Zoning By-law or the Oak Ridges Moraine Conservation Plan.

5. That the Clerk or the Clerk's designate is authorized to administer the Fill Control By-law process and to issue Fill Permits.
6. That By-law Number 99-111 to amend By-law Number 97-84 be repealed.

**READ a FIRST and SECOND** time this 6<sup>th</sup> day of May, 2002.

**READ a THIRD** time **AND FINALLY PASSED** this 6<sup>th</sup> day of May, 2002.
