NOTICE TO PROPERTY OWNERS

DESTROY WEEDS

NOTICE is hereby given to all persons in possession of land, in accordance with the Weed Control Act, R.S.O. 1990, Chapter W.5, Sections 3, 16 and 23 THAT unless noxious weeds growing on their lands within the Municipality of the Township of King are destroyed throughout the season, the Municipality may enter upon said lands and have the weeds destroyed, charging costs against the land, as set out in the Weed Control Act.

(All properties ten (10) acres or less may have noxious weeds destroyed without notice to the owner).

NOTE:

The following changes to the Noxious Weed List came into effect on January 1, 2015:
