(A Phosphorous removal agent)

At its meeting of February 22nd, 2010, Council of the Township of King will receive a presentation from the Lake Simcoe Region Conservation Authority regarding the application of PhoslockTM in the Holland River in the Holland Marsh Canal System.

Phoslock is a phosphorous removal agent which has been used in a number of countries to treat lakes and rivers as a quick fix remedy to control phosphorous while more permanent phosphorous management solutions are being developed.
