Get the Facts

Animal Control By-laws

Any person who owns, harbours, or possesses a dog shall clean up and dispose of any excrement left by said dog on any property whether public or private in the Township of King.

The owner of every dog shall, on or before the 15th day of April in each and every year, or upon becoming the owner of a dog after the 1st day of February, register such dog with the Township of King and procure a license for the current year for the dog.

No owner of a dog shall permit any dog to bark or create any noise that is likely to disturb the inhabitants of the Township of that constitutes a public nuisance.

No person who owns, harbours, or possesses a dog shall allow it, whether leashed or unleashed, to trespass on private property.

No owner of a dog shall allow the dog to run at large within the limits of the Township.



Who to Call

To report any cruelty or neglect on an animal, contact the Ontario SPCA at (905) 898-7122 to speak with an investigator.

To report any sick or injured animals, contact the Toronto Wildlife Centre (416) 631-0662

To report dogs barking, dogs/cats running at large, clean-up of pet excrement, or animal attacks, contact the Animal Control Department at (905) 832- 8505 or 1-855-227-7297.

For dog licensing and kennel licensing inquiries, contact the Township of King By-law Enforcement Department at (905) 833-4002.

For wildlife inquires such as coyote or fox sightings, please contact the Ministry of Natural Resources at (905) 713-7400 to receive additional information.



Location and Hours

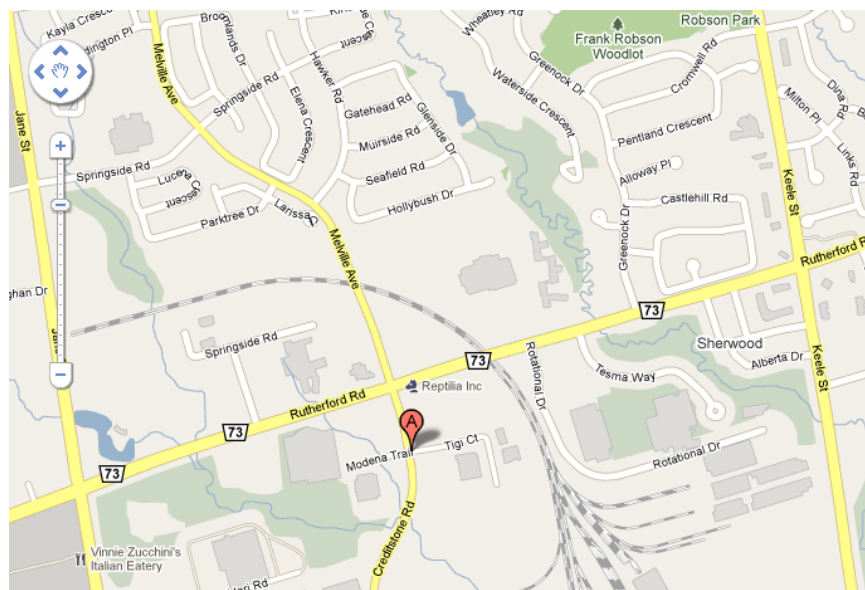
The Animal Shelter, is located at 70 Tigi Court Unit 8 (main intersection, South of Rutherford Road and East of Creditstone Road).
