

Property Signage

The Township encourages all businesses to install high quality signage that contributes to the character of King's vibrant communities, including projecting signs, wall signs with overhead lighting, and ground signs with architectural and landscaped features.

Signs Requiring Permits

Commercial properties may apply for a permit to install up to one (1) ground sign, two (2) wall signs, and projecting and canopy signs. Mobile signs may be installed for thirty (30) days with a permit. Please attend the By-law Enforcement offices to apply for sign permits.

If you are a tenant of a commercial plaza or property, please ensure you have your landlord's permission to apply for a sign permit and check if there are any special requirements for signage that may apply through property agreements with the Township.

Sign Permit Fees

Permanent Signs: \$100 + \$15/m² per sign Mobile Signs: \$100 per permit (30-day max.)

Signs Allowed Without Permits

One (1) A-frame sign is allowed without a permit, up to 1.25m height and 0.77m² per side.

Help wanted signs and window signs do not require a permit. For safety reasons, window signs may only cover 25% of the windowed area to provide emergency responders with visibility into the structure.

Prohibited Signs

The Township prohibits or discourages certain forms of signage that detract from the visual appeal of King's villages and the rural character of the community.

Sign By-law #2013-127 prohibits:

- Backlit signs
- Roof signs
- Inflatables, banners and flags
- Moving or flashing LED/video screens
- Wrapped vehicles parked for the purposes of advertising
- Billboards and off-site directional signs
