King/Vaughan: Noise Wall Installations

Wednesday, September 25, 2025 - January 2027 Monday to Friday, 11:00 p.m. to 6:00 a.m.

What You Need to Know:

We will be installing multiple noise walls along King-Vaughan. This work will be conducted during nighttime hours from Monday to Friday.

What to Expect:

Contractors will be working to install several noise walls around the station, primarily along Keele and McDonald streets. Residents may experience noise and vibration from the use of heavy construction equipment including concrete trucks, a skid steer, a generator, and drill rigs. These noise walls will help reduce sound volumes associated with the passage of trains and future works.



Pedestrian/Commuter Impacts:

We understand that overnight work is not ideal and will take every measure we can to mitigate impacts to residents in the area, including noise mufflers, only running equipment as it is needed, ensuring lights are pointed into the corridor and not at homes, and using monitors to measure noise and vibration. We appreciate your understanding and patience as we work to bring you better service along the Barrie line.
