

King City GO: Upcoming Overnight Works

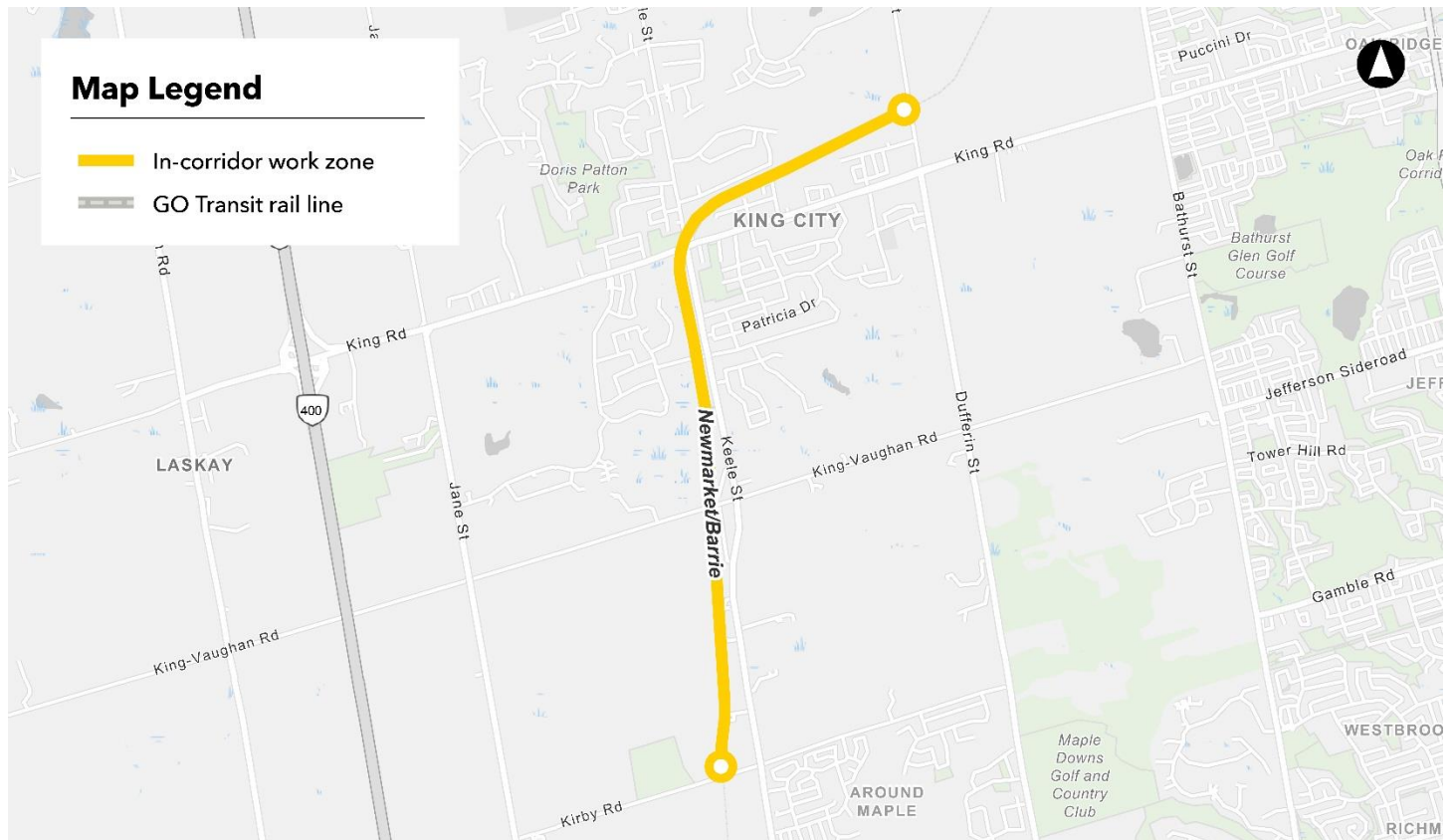


Figure 1: Approximate area of work zones. Not to scale. Metrolinx image.

What Is Happening

To support rail corridor and station enhancements at and around King City GO, Metrolinx will be conducting Raceway and electrical work along with excavation and grading works overnight. The work will involve the following activities:

- **Raceway and Electrical Work:**

- o Installation of railway corridor raceway duct banks (RCRs) from Kirby Road to Dufferin Street. (see Figure 1)
- o Electrical work associated with improvements at King City GO
- o This work will be done overnight from 11:00 p.m. to 6:00 a.m.

- **Excavation and Grading Work:**

- o Excavation and grading work along the rail corridor from Kirby Road to Dufferin Street. (see Figure 1)
- o Work will occur overnight from 11:00 p.m. to 6:00 a.m.

We understand that overnight work is not ideal. Metrolinx will implement mitigations wherever possible to reduce the impact of the activities on residents in the area. We appreciate your patience and understanding as we work to bring better and faster service to the Barrie line.

WHAT TO EXPECT

- Raceway and electrical, as well as grading and excavation overnight works.
- Equipment to be used include an excavator, dozers, skid steer, forklift and trucks.
- Fencing will be installed around the work areas
- Nearby residents may experience some noise associated with these activities.
- Sound and air monitoring technology will be utilized to ensure that noise levels do not exceed an average limit of 65-decibel over an 8-16-hour work period, in compliance with Metrolinx's construction noise criteria for residential work.
- Vehicle speeds will be reduced
- Machinery will only be turned on and used when necessary to avoid idle noise.
- Water will be sprayed onto soil to avoid dust build up while excavating.

HOURS OF WORK

- The work will take place on weeknights from Monday till Friday
- All work is overnight from 11:00 p.m. to 6:00 a.m.

LOCATION OF WORK

- All work will take place within the rail corridor from Kirby Road till Dufferin Street.
- There will be access points at Kirby Road, King Vaughan Road, Station Road, Dufferin Street, and Keele Street.

PEDESTRIAN DETAILS

- There will be no pedestrian impacts.

TRAFFIC DETAILS

- There will be minor traffic impacts at the access points.
- There will be traffic control flagging to help direct equipment into the work area

TRANSIT IMPACTS

- There will be no transit impacts.

COMMUNITY ENGAGEMENT

- We thank you for your patience and cooperation as we strive to bring you enhancements at King City GO station.
