Project

This project includes:

- Paving of the existing gravel road
- Paving of driveway entrances
- Roadside ditch grading, as required
- Culvert replacements, as required



Where?

Mill Road

(King Road to King Vaughan Road)

Elmpine Trail

(Mill Road to end)



Why?

To improve environmental, maintenance, and safety aspects of our roads, the Township's Asset Management Plan includes directive to convert all gravel roads to asphalt by 2040.



When?

Start: July 2026

End: Fall 2026



Impacts

- Access for local residents will be maintained with minimum one lane of traffic.
- Short-term full road closures may be required and will be communicated in advance
- Access for Emergency Services, Student Transportation, Waste Collection, and Postal Services will be maintained.
