Not to mention chai, cocoa, shakes and lots and lots of yummy vegetarian wraps, sandwiches and soups.

The Schomberg Pub & Patio

This gastropub in a heritage home is dedicated to honest to goodness delicious pub fare, beer and fun. The beautiful patio overlooks the Schomberg River and is open whenever Mother Nature allows – usually April–October. You can't get more relaxed than this.

Main Street is home to CIBC, RONA and the Schomberg Post Office, ensuring a steady stream of customers all day long, who then choose to also frequent the shops and restaurants. An astonishing 95.6% of residents report using the Schomberg Post Office (2018 resident survey).

The Activation Plan builds off of and extends activities themed around the 4 major events that take place on Main Street, each of which draws thousands of visitors. Main Street specific street banners ensure exceptional placemaking during these times. Additional activations, including A Taste of Main and Sidewalk Saturdays bring a steady stream of people to the street.

ONGOING BEAUTIFICATION AND INFRASTRUCTURE PROJECTS ENHANCE MAIN STREET'S DELIGHTFUL EXPERIENCE

King Township continues to make significant investments in Main Street's physical design.

Main Street continues to be enhanced, including a complete renovation of the Schomberg Community Hall that will include exterior access washrooms. Lion's Park, right next to the Schomberg River, has been redesigned and upgraded to have hydro, which will transform it into a perfect community gathering place.

Broadband installed in 2020 means access to big city amenities without losing small town charm.





PROPERTY IMPROVEMENT GRANTS

Commercial and mixed use properties located in the village core, as well as residential properties being converted to commercial use, such as the property featured here, are eligible for matching funding from the Community Improvement Plan. The Plan outlines financial incentives for property owners and tenants to invest in their property.

The shops and restaurants on Main Street are the heart of the village and give Schomberg its small town charm.

SCHOMBERG RESIDENTS LOVE WHERE THEY LIVE

At the September Street Gallery, Main Street is closed to allow residents and visitors to enjoy a wide range of artworks for sale, each joined by its creator.

Main Street Christmas

The first Saturday of every December, A Main Street Christmas draws thousands of visitors and kicks off a month of festivities.

Scarecrows

The Schomberg Scarecrows is a whimsical community experience that fosters creativity, enthusiasm and pride.
