Election Candidates and Registered Third Party Advertiser Sign Reference Card

Election signs will be permitted in King Township commencing 28 days prior to Election Day for Municipal elections or one day after the day of the writ for Provincial and Federal elections. Signs must be removed 3 days following the election.

Registration/Permit Fees

King

Non-refundable fee of \$100.

Security deposit of \$250 held for permit duration.

If any election signs are removed for violating King's Sign By-law, a penalty of \$20 will be deducted from the security deposit.

York Region

Non-refundable fee of \$250

Size Restrictions

King

Signs at campaign headquarters are not restricted by size.

Signs on Private Property must not exceed a sign area of 3 m^2 (32.29 ft²).

Signs on Public Property must have a sign area no less than 1 m^2 (10.76 ft²) and no greater than 1.5 m^2 (16.15 ft²).

York Region

Signs at Regional intersections must not exceed 1.22 m (4 ft) high and 1.22 m (4 ft) wide.

Placement Limitations

If the signs do not meet the following limitations the sign will be removed.

No more than two signs per property and no more than two per intersection (one per corner).

Signs permitted at intersections subject to setbacks (see diagrams on back for King and York Region).

The Candidate or Third Party Advertiser ("TPA") is responsible to ensure that all precautions are taken to avoid damage to existing utilities and objects in the road right of way.

Property owner/occupant's authorization required to place signs on private property.

Signs must not:

Be placed at any of the following: Wellington Street West and Dufferin Street, Highway 27 and Old King Road, Keele Street and Cavell Avenue, King Road and Hoop Street, and, LLoydtown-Aurora Road/Kettleby Road and Jane Street.

Impair or obstruct the visibility of vehicular or pedestrian traffic, warning devices such as railway, traffic or municipal signs.

Be placed on any centre median, traffic island or centre boulevard within a road allowance/highway.

Be placed on or adjacent to any voting place, or public property used for parks, recreational, institutional or cultural purposes.

Display the Township logo or crest.

Note:

TPA signs must contain the name of the registered third party, the municipality where they are registered, and a telephone number, mailing address, or e-mail address for contact purposes.


