Spring Roads Maintenance

The Township of King's Transportation division maintains 677 lane km of roads, including 126 lane km of gravel roads and 551 km of asphalt roads.



Ditching

Proper drainage is crucial for road maintenance. Regular ditching prevents water accumulation, erosion and road damage, ensuring road safety.

Potholes

Swift pothole repairs using AI technology help identify, prioritize and fix potholes, improving road conditions and safety. To report a pothole repair request, visit **king.ca/transportation**.




Gravel Roads

The Township maintains 126 lane km of gravel roads with grading, dust control and repairs. Calcium chloride is applied annually to control dust and prevent erosion.

Street sweeping

Annual street sweeping in spring removes debris and prevents storm sewer clogging, enhancing road safety and appearance. Parks staff work with the street sweeper provided by the Roads division to sweep the parking lots and facility/park walkways.



Pavement marking

The Township designs and maintains pavement markings to guide traffic, mark pedestrian crossings and indicate obstacles. Yellow lines separate traffic moving in opposite directions, while white lines separate traffic moving in the same direction.

Sod repairs

The Transportation division promptly repairs plow damage to roads and sidewalks, ensuring safety and functionality. Residents can file a claim for sod damage repairs to their property at **king.ca/OnlineServices**.
