#14: Dufferin Between 15 th and King`	What is the scope?	Multi Use Path (MUP) on Dufferin between 15 th and Tatton Court has been built by the KCE group, however there remains a small portion between Tatton and King Rd that the KCE group has yet to build (pending agreements from Metrolinx). This project therefore, should only be for the remainder (Tatton Court to King Road approx. 550m). Cost has been adjusted to reflect works completed to date.
#15: 15 th from Keele to Dufferin	What is the scope?	MUP: Fills a critical gap between two developments constructing multi-use paths in northeast King City. This connection supports growth-related demand, reduces pressure on road infrastructure, and enhances active transportation
#20: Dufferin at Country Days School	What is the scope?	Safe crossing is needed to support safe access to the school, particularly in response to growth in the King East quadrant and increasing traffic volumes along Dufferin. Specific improvements will be determined through future detailed studies to address site-specific challenges and opportunities.
