### Development Charge Update – 2020

#### Project Schedule for Completion and Developer Consultations

The Township of King is updating its Development Charges By-law and is completing a comprehensive Development Charges Background Study. The following outlines some key dates for this process.

Last week of October	Publish statutory notice of November 30, 2020 public meeting
November 12	Publish DC Background Study, including new draft bylaw AND Publish report to November 16, 2020 Council, which is to be referred to the public meeting on November 30, 2020
November 27, 2020	Private consultation session with the development community by invitation (date may be updated) Additional session may be added if required.
November 30, 2020	Public Meeting of Council (virtual meeting format) to review DC Background Study and Report, including presentation from Town's consultants Any member of the public may speak or make written submission.
January 11, 2021	Regular meeting of Council to enact updated DC Bylaw and rates. Any member of the public may speak or make written submission.
