GET READY for Snow!



Safety First!

- Clear off all snow before driving
- Ensure all lights are in working order
- Top up fluids and check your tire pressure
- Ensure all bicycle lights are working and that reflective gear is worn when riding
- Stay well back from snowplows, with particular attention to when the snowplows have their 4-way flashers on
- Consider using York Region Transit
- Give extra time and space to stop in bad weather
- Pedestrians should always be aware of their surroundings and ensure to make eye contact with approaching drivers and cyclists
- Plan ahead! Check your local forecast



Remember

- Clear catch basins and culverts of litter, leaves and other debris to prevent flooding
- Clear snow and ice around fire hydrants
- Remove hockey and basketball nets and other decorative landscaping
- Set waste bins a minimum of 1 metre from the curb and not on a snowbank



Parking Restriction in Effect

- No parking starting nov. 1st 2am-6am
- Do not park on the road from November 1st to April 15th between the hours of 2:00am and 6:00am
- Do not park your vehicle on the roadway during a snow plowing, sanding or salting event
- Do not place snow or ice onto the road
- Do not pile snow onto your driveway apron, this can block sightlines

Windrows

- Tip: Reduce the amount of snow left in your windrow by shoveling snow from your driveway apron onto the boulevard prior to plowing. Use a proper shovel or “scoop” shovel.
- Consider other community resources (volunteer groups like the Snow Angels, neighbourhood kids, or a private contractor)
